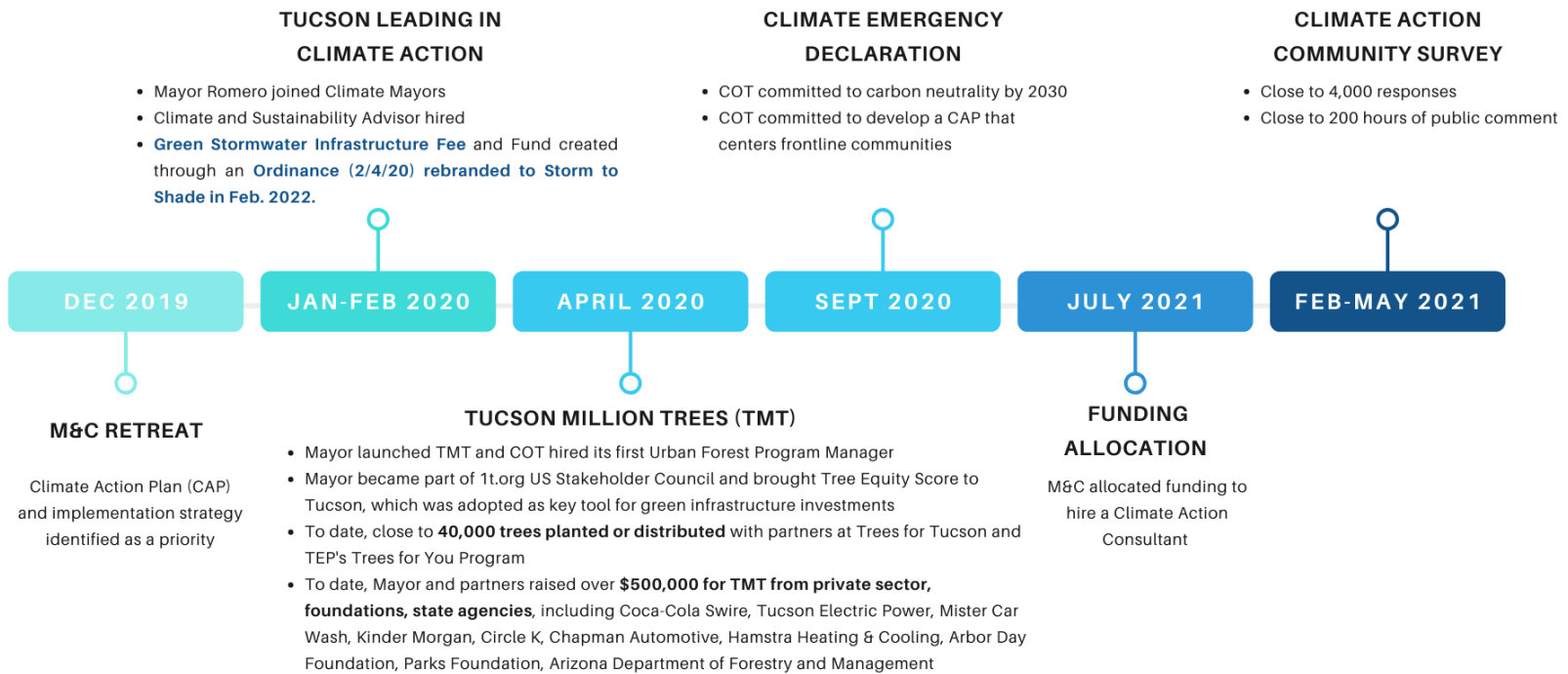


# City of Tucson Climate Action Planning and Implementation Efforts

## ELECTRIC VEHICLE READINESS ROADMAP

- EV Roadmap draft adopted in April 2021, final draft adopted in Feb. 2022 with EV website launched
- COT launched 5 E-buses, ordered 5 more, pursuing 5 more
- **Adopted EV ready code amendment for all new residential development (June 2021)** and undergoing same process for multi-family and commercial buildings
- Developed COT's vehicle fleet transition plan (draft)

## CLIMATE ACTION CONSULTANT

- Released Request for Proposals
- Reviewed and evaluated 13 proposals
- Interviewed 4 consulting firms
- Selected and hired Buro Happold

## PLAN TUCSON

Plan Tucson will incorporate existing COT's planning efforts including, **Climate Action and Adaptation Plan**; Move Tucson; One Water 2100; P-CHIP and other key planning strategies.



### CLIMATE LISTENING SESSIONS

- Mayor partnered with University Climate Change Coalition (UC3) to pursue funding and implement project
- **Year long project** with listening sessions happening in March-July
- 14 community listening sessions implemented
- Over 150 Tucsonans directly reached/listened to
- Over 1,300 unique community climate concerns and recommendations gathered
- 29 community members trained as facilitators
- 8 high school and college students interning at Mayor's office trained in data entry and coding

### LOS REALES SUSTAINABILITY CAMPUS

- M&C committed to becoming a **zero waste city by 2050** (Sept 2020)
- COT inaugurated Compost Facility at Sustainability Campus (April 2021)
- M&C renamed Los Reales Landfill to **Los Reales Sustainability Campus and embraced waste as an asset (July 2021)**
- COT developed conceptual framework for the Sustainability Campus and zero waste roadmap (Sept. 2021)
- In process of developing Zero Waste Plan
- Piloting glass reusing and ByFusion Block projects
- Evaluating landfill gas best end-uses

### FINAL CLIMATE ACTION PLAN
